


Lent is the 40 day season of spiritual growth within Christian churches.

Early Christians first observed this season as a time to prepare new believers for baptism on Easter—the Day of Resurrection. During this time, those new to the faith were instructed in the life and the teachings of Jesus Christ, and they committed themselves to this new faith through the practice of spiritual disciplines such as prayer, worship, study of scripture, service to others, and fasting.
