**Leader**: When things aren't as they should be...

Others: Our God loves us.

Leader: When we make mistakes or mess up, Others: Our God loves us.

Leader: When everything seems just right with the world... Others: Our God loves us.

**Leader**: No matter what and all the time, **Others**: Our God loves us.

Leader: We can love God, and we can love others because... Others: Our God loves us.

Leader: Thank you God, that you are with us. Thank you that you love us always and no matter what. May the candle of love be a reminder today and throughout the Advent season that you love us and invite us to show your love to others.
