Make beautiful music with your IRA - Are you older than 72 and have those pesky IRA or 401(k) Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) that you need to take for 2022? Do you enjoy the music program at Grace? Would you like hear about a way that you can satisfy all or some of your RMDs, not have to pay income taxes on the distribution AND be able to make beautiful music with the funds at the same time?

You may be able to take advantage of a <u>Qualified Charitable Distribution</u> (QCD), that allows you to have your RMD(s) sent directly to Grace Lutheran Church, to help us replace our baby grand piano, that has reached the end of its life span and can no longer be tuned.

You can contact the financial institution that holds your IRA/401(k)/Tax Sheltered Annuity and ask them how you can take advantage of a Qualified Charitable Distribution. You can also direct any questions to Jack Claypotch at 610-489-8201.
