**Did you know that Montgomery County is experiencing a crisis of homelessness and a lack of affordable housing?** Here's a few statistics (from Montgomery County): In January of 2021, 568 people were identified as homeless. Between 2021 -2022, homelessness rose by at least 118%. 50% of the clients of the only year round emergency shelter for single adults are over 55 years old. That year round shelter lost it's lease on June 30, 2022, and is now struggling to serve the clients that relied upon them for help.



What can Grace do? The Grace council is currently exploring options for our rental unit above the office, which will soon be undergoing some very needed updating. If you are interested in being part of discussions & plans to minister to someone in need of affordable housing in our neighborhood, please see Pastor Krais, council president Jack Claypotch, or any member of council.
