From the Deacon's Desk: Who is the ELCA?

Last month, the ELCA held their triannual Churchwide Assembly. It was held in Columbus, OH. This is the time when delegates from all over the country gather for churchwide business. I'm guessing for most of you, this isn't something that was on your radar. And it occurs to me that maybe there are some questions that you have in general about our denomination, the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. So here are some quick facts. I encourage you to go to the national church's website ELCA.org to learn more:

- The ELCA was formed on January 1, 1988, by the merging of three Lutheran church bodies. As of 2020, it has just over 3 million baptized members and almost 9,000 congregations.
- Our Presiding Bishop is Elizabeth Eaton
- National Church offices are in Chicago
- Supports 150 missionaries around the world
- There are 65 Synods in the ELCA.
 - Ours is the Southeastern PA Synod and our Bishop is Patricia Davenport.
- The ELCA belongs to the World Council of Churches, the National Council of Churches of Christ in the USA, and the Lutheran World Federation. The ELCA is in full communion with the Episcopal Church, Moravian Church, Presbyterian Church (USA), Reformed Church in America, United Church of Christ, and the United Methodist Church.
