

Advent at Grace - Hunger impacts everything.

During Advent, bless someone with the gift of a meal! Participate in our fundraising event on the Sundays in Advent, by purchasing meals for people in need, globally. Our Advent tree will start off bare. As people purchase various quantities of meals, a star will be

hung on the tree. Help decorate our tree by participating! The stars represent specific numbers of meals purchased. Our "star" denominations are: feed 1 person/1 day = \$1; feed 5 people/1 day = \$5; feed 2 people/1 week = \$15; feed 1 person/1 month = \$35; feed 7 people/1 week = \$50. Or, consider just making a donation. The money raised will be used toward the Rise Against Hunger food packing event on April 29...stay tuned for details. Cash or checks accepted.
