

Grief Lectionary: The 6-week course called "The Grief Lectionary" will begin in March. This small group study is meant to be a companion for grieving people of faith using the Bible as a guide. Each study uses a particular scripture story and joins it to a part of the grief journey, loosely correlated with the s stages of grief. We will meet on the following Sundays after the second service at 11:30am. Each session is about 75 minutes



long so we will finish before 1:00pm. The dates for the sessions are: 3/12, 4/2, 4/16, 4/23, 5/7 & 5/21. A sign-up sheet will be posted in the 6th Avenue entrance, or you can let Deacon Allison know if you plan on attending.



Lenten Study: Journeys through Lent—Lent begins with Ash Wednesday on Feb. 22nd. This year, as we journey through Lent, on Sunday mornings we'll focus on different journeys in scripture, and for our Lenten Study we'll be using the book, "Following the Movements of the Spirit", by Henri Nouwen, to learn where God's Spirit is leading us. What is this journey of faith prodding me toward? Where is God leading me? We will be meeting by Zoom, each
