As we make our way through this season of the Epiphany (the star in the East) we are rapidly approaching the season of Lent. Many of us Christians have grown up with long-standings practices (Shrove Tuesday pancakes, ashes, mid-week worship, palms, institution of Holy Communion, and the deep darkness of Good Friday) in preparation for the blazing



light of Easter. Over the years, and through the pandemic, some of these practices have changed, and some have been maintained.

Here at Grace Lutheran, we have the following plans for 2024:

Tuesday, Feb. 13 – Shrove Tuesday Pancake Dinner; Organized by our Youth in the Fellowship Hall

Wednesday, Feb. 14 – Ash Wednesday (two worship opportunities):

Noon – Royersford United Methodist Church will have a service with Ashes – to which we have been invited & 6:00 pm – Grace Lutheran will have a service with Ashes (to which we have invited Royersford United Methodist)

Sundays of Lent – the theme for this season is CROSSING OVER. With Grace in the midst of significant transition we felt it would be helpful to visit Scripture stories about crossing over (Jesus being driven into the wilderness, Joshua crossing the Jordan River, prophet moving from Elijah to Elisha, Paul ship wrecked, Moses crossing the Red Sea, Jesus entering Jerusalem on a donkey)

EACH WEDNESDAY we will post a video meditation following the same Crossing Over theme. There will be NO mid-week in-person gatherings.

In Lent, we return to God in love because we were first loved; despite the finite nature of this life, the love of God abounds. It doesn't end. So when we receive that cross of ash on our foreheads on Ash Wednesday, we can know that it is also in the shape of a heart.
