The members of the Call Committee are Jack Perry, Chair; Angela Feist, John Salamone, Jackie Perry, Bud Meredith, and Trish McGarry. They are under the guidance of the Conference Dean, Pastor Chris McKinstry (St. James Lutheran, Limerick) and have begun their important and sensitive work.

They will confidentially review the documents of pastoral candidates provided by the Office of the Bishop. Interview the pastoral candidates they wish to know more deeply. Eventually, identify one of the pastoral candidates, who they will refer to the Council. The Council will then interview this pastoral candidate and if the Council concurs THEN the Council will publicly share the name of the pastoral candidate and arrange a time for them to lead worship, meet the staff, and greet you.

After all of that, the Council will establish the date for a Call Vote, at which meeting the membership will vote to extend a call for this pastoral candidate to become Grace's next pastor.

This is indeed a time of new things. Please be patient with the process and keep the members of the Call Committee and their work in your regular prayers.

From the Deacon's Desk: Being a Deacon Part One – What is a Deacon?

As we transition to a new pastor, it seemed like a good time for a refresher on what it means that I am a Deacon (and not a pastor) here at Grace.

The role of Deacon in the ELCA came from the joining of three separate rosters:

Diakonal Ministers, Deaconesses, and Associates in Ministry (AIMs). (Before the joining, I was in the latter roster). The new roster that was created is called the Ministry of Word & Service (rather than Word & Sacrament, which is the roster for pastors).

There were multiple reasons for the creation of the new roster, but the most prominent was that this puts us now in line with our ecumenical partners (Episcopal, Methodist, etc.) who also have the roster of deacon.

Both pastors and deacons are called to preach the Word of God, but there are differences between the two that are important to know. Pastors are called to shepherd and lead congregations and also to administer the sacraments of Baptism and Holy Communion. Deacons are called to have one foot in the church and one foot in the world in service.

Deacons serve many roles in the ELCA and the roster is still one that we are all growing into as it is still a fairly new one. Many serve in social service organizations; as chaplains; or in various administrative functions at ELCA agencies. Others serve in congregations in a variety of roles.

Next time...what it means that I am a deacon specifically at Grace.

Rise Against Hunger Registration—Sign-ups began for our April 27th packing event on **Tues.**, **March 12th and will be open through Fri.**, **April 12th**. Here's what you need to know for registering:



First: Please indicate in the drop-down box which "team" (congregation) you are part of. (Grace Lutheran Church)

Second: You do not need to pay attention to the "amount raised" number. That is for how much is raised via the online portal. You are, however, welcome and encouraged to make a donation on the portal.

Third: Please click the box(es) of the times you are signing up for. There is a box for set up, the packing shift, and clean up. Please consider staying to help clean up.

Fourth: Family members don't need to be signed up separately. One person signs up and indicates how many you are bringing along.

Fifth: There is a waiver at the bottom of the registration. By signing up you are agreeing to it. Registration will close on April 12th or when we reach 100 volunteers, whichever comes first.

If you are unable to register via the portal, please let Deacon Allison know and she will register you. You will need an email address in order to register.


Adult Faith Formation Opportunities—Sunday Mornings at 9:15am
