From the Deacon's Desk: Being a Deacon Part Two – Being a Deacon at Grace



Last month I wrote about what a deacon is in the ELCA. So what does it mean that I am a deacon specifically at Grace? As I said last month, ELCA deacons serve in many different capacities: social service organizations; as chaplains; or in various administrative functions at ELCA agencies. Then there are deacons who serve in congregations, some as music ministers, and some like me.

I was called here to Grace with three areas of responsibility: Adult Education/Formation; Evangelism/Faith Engagement; and assisting with Worship. While this doesn't preclude me from helping in other areas – working with social ministry, or with Kelsey in children's ministry, or assisting with pastoral care – those are not the areas to which I am specifically called.

As we get ready for a new pastor to join us, we want him or her to have a chance to shine! So for many of the things folks have been coming to me about since Pastor Krais left (pastoral care issues, administration issues, or questions about worship), it will be important to go to them rather than to me. This will be an essential way for you to get to know this person and for them to become quickly integrated into the congregation.

As a reminder as well, I am a partial-time, 25-hour a week Deacon. I generally work from home on Mondays and am in the office Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays (that sometimes changes, so if you want to meet with me, best to email me to schedule a time). I am off on Fridays.

No matter what my areas of responsibility, I am so happy to be serving here at Grace and my door is open! Please don't hesitate to check in with me with any questions or concerns you have.




Richard Harshaw's group continues to meet in the Choir Room (L04) at 9:15 am.
