Dear Siblings in Christ,

Many years ago, long before I became a pastor, I learned how to play the violin. Eventually, I joined the praise band at St. John's Ridge Valley, my home congregation. My fellow musicians clipped a small lapel microphone onto my violin to amplify its acoustic sound so that it would not be lost among the other amped instruments. However, the microphone was so sensitive that it picked up the distracting sound of every breath I took, and so I began to stifle and even hold my breath as I played.

Then one Christmas, my fellow musicians gifted me with a digital pick-up, which attached to my violin's bridge to pick up the vibrations, sending the sound of the violin directly to the sound system and eliminating the need for the clip-on microphone. The sound of my violin improved with the better technology.

But there was something else, and I didn't notice it at first. Because of the microphone, I had been holding back my breath for so long, that it took me a few weeks to realize that I didn't have to hold my breath anymore. Without restriction, I could move the air freely through my whole body again and simply breathe. This changed everything: My sound improved dramatically, I was happier and more satisfied with my music making, and my band mates could hear and feel the difference, too. I learned that my ability to play beautifully was completely dependent upon my freedom to breathe and move.

One of my favorite classical recordings is Zuill Bailey playing Bach's Cello Suites. I love to hear him play, not just because he is a superb musician, but because I can distinctly hear each breath he takes as he plays. It's one of the precious few recordings I've heard that didn't edit out the breath sounds.

And so I wonder...

What if the spiritual life is like that too? What if our ability to love and serve, as Jesus would have us do, is connected to our absolute freedom to breathe with the Holy Spirit as deeply as our souls can hold? And to move unrestricted in the knowledge that God loves us no matter what. How much more beautiful might our lives sound and feel if we could just remember to breathe in the gift of the Spirit and breathe out that which impedes God's love?

Creator, Lover & Sustainer,
As in the beginning, you breathe into us animating us with the gift of life.
Yet sin contorts us, fear restricts us, and our anxieties keep us from
living freely as you desire us to do.
Help us to release to you all that binds us,
which we now name before you aloud or silently from our hearts...
By your Spirit, fill us deeply with your life-giving breath
that we may live and serve others out of the unrestricted abundance of your love.
In the precious name of Jesus, we pray. Amen.


